

2010 DEUTSCHE BANK CHAMPIONSHIP



2010 saw Charley Hoffman win the Deutsche Bank for the first and only time in his career. Hoffman entered the round 4 strokes behind Jason Day. Hoffman started the final round by carding a birdie on the 4 out of the first 5 holes. He then proceeded to shoot (-6) 29 on the back to win the tournament. Hoffman finished at (-22) and tied the lowest final score (262) and margin of victory record (5 strokes) in Deutsche Bank Championship history.
