Golf Course Rules and Regulations

“The Club” is defined as TPC Louisiana.

All Annual Pass program applicants of the Club should familiarize themselves with the following rules and regulations which have been adopted for the common good and must be observed for the same reason.

Club Facilities: The Club reserves the right to restrict the use of the Club’s facilities including both golf courses, practice areas and food outlets at certain times during the year; for example, during tournaments, outings, special events and overseeding.

Starting Times: It is necessary to reserve a starting time for play. Starting times are on a first come, first serve basis.

- Reservations can be made up to a maximum of 14 days in advance by calling the Golf Shop at (504) 436-8721.
- Cancellations of your starting time must be done at a minimum of 48 hours prior to your starting time. Inside 48 hours, the person reserving the time may be charged accordingly.
- No shows will be handled in the same fashion as cancellations inside 48 hours. If you do not show up for your starting time, you can be charged for the round of golf. If you are making starting times for other Annual Passholders in your name, you are held responsible if someone does not show up.
- Reservations for single players are allowed but handled on a first come first serve basis. Walk up play on the same day is encouraged based on availability.

Guest Play:

- Each Annual Passholder is allowed to invite and make reservations for guests at the Annual Passholder guest rate. Reservations can be made up to a maximum of 14 days in advance and all guests must be accompanied by the Annual Passholder to receive the guest price.
- Group play of 16 players or more will pay the daily fee rate plus a \$10 tournament management fee. Starting time for 16 players or more must be made by calling our Head Professional at (504)436-8725. All groups must be accompanied by the Annual Passholder.

Member Decorum Policy: All Guests, Annual Pass Holders and Designees shall respect and treat with dignity other Guests, Annual Pass Holders, Designees, and Club employees. In particular, Guests and Annual Pass Holders shall not engage in offensive, harassing or other inappropriate conduct. Such behavior is inconsistent with the Club’s philosophy of mutual respect for all. Violation of this policy by any Guest, Annual Pass Holder, Designee(s) or their Immediate Family Members could affect privileges.

Play Registration: All players must register in the Golf Shop before your starting time to pay a cart fee. This includes using the Practice Facility.

Golf Carts:

- No more than two riders and two golf bags permitted per golf cart.
- Golf carts must stay on cart paths in the vicinity of all greens and tees as denoted by signs.
- Private owned cars are not permitted at the club or on the course.
- Children under 16 may not drive golf carts. A junior golfer, ages 16 and older, must have a valid driver's license to drive carts.

Practice Facilities:

- Pre-round practice: The use of the TPC Louisiana practice facility for warming up prior to your scheduled starting time is permitted all year.
- Practice Areas: All practice shall be confined to our designated practice areas and practice greens provided for this purpose.
- Practice Only Restrictions: The TPC Louisiana practice facility is only open to Annual Passholders or paying guests. The practice facility is closed to the public.

Speed of Play (Pace): It should be a goal of all players to complete their round in 4 hours and 20 minutes. This amount of time is more than adequate providing all players remain aware of the rights of others to play without delay. It is the responsibility of each group to keep pace with the group in front of them. If your group falls one complete hole behind the group ahead, you may be required to move into position and possibly miss a hole. It is each group's responsibility to be observant of its position on the course and keep pace. It is also the responsibility of all groups to freely inform the Course Advisor (Ranger) of less observant groups if the pace of play is adversely affected by them. The Course Advisor has the authority to keep play moving at the proper pace for all player enjoyment.

Course Care: Annual Passholders are reminded to help repair ball marks, sand fill divots and rake bunkers during play.

Golf Club Usage: Each player is required to have a set of golf clubs; sharing is not permitted. Rental clubs are available.

Food & Beverage: Only food and beverages purchased from the club may be taken onto the course. Due to the State of Louisiana liquor laws, all distribution of alcohol on the course must be controlled by the Club.

Dress Code: Golfers are required to wear proper golf attire at all times. The following attire is not permitted; any denim (jeans, etc.), bathing attire, collarless shirts, gym shorts, tank tops, tube and halter tops, mesh shirts, cutoffs, short shorts, tennis outfits and dress of this type. Bermuda length shorts are permissible.

Lessons: Golf instruction is available by appointment through the TPC Louisiana Golf Shop. Annual Passholders are not permitted to bring their own instructors.

Pets: Pets are not permitted in the clubhouse or on the course grounds. Service animals are required to be approved by Club management.

Damage to Club Property: Any damage caused by an Annual Passholder to the Club's property or grounds will be paid for by the individual responsible. In the case of a guest, the sponsoring Annual Passholder is held responsible.

Club Rule Violations: Annual Passholders are subject to penalties at the discretion of the Club which include suspension or revocation of privileges. You will be notified both verbally and in writing.

Modification: The club reserves the right to modify the Rules and Regulations at anytime due to special circumstances and at the discretion of the Club.
