

Local Rules

Golf Canada Rules shall govern play

- 1. BUNKERS:** Sandy areas through the green are deemed to be waste areas and not hazards. A player may ground one's club without penalty.
- 2. OUT OF BOUNDS or LOST BALL:** When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed under Local Rule E-5. 2 stroke penalty
- 3. BOUNDARIES:** Out of Bounds is defined by (a) white stakes, (b) public roadways, (c) parking lot, (d) perimeter fencing as well as the wire fencing alongside the railway track that runs through the course. Note: A ball that crosses a road or fence alongside the railway track and comes to rest beyond that road or fence is out of bounds.
- 4. PATHS:** All paths and maintenance roads are deemed immovable obstructions and relief may be taken. Rule 16. No Penalty.

CARTS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN FESCUE GRASSES OR NATURAL AREAS
All yardages are measured to center of greens. Sprinkler heads are marked.**
