

Local Rules
Golf Canada Rules shall govern play

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS or LOST BALL:** When a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed under Local Rule E-5.2 stroke penalty.
2. **ROCK WALLS:** The piled stone rock wall located in the general area throughout the course are deemed integral objects. There is no relief without penalty.
3. **BOUNDARIES:** Out of Bounds is defined by (a) white stakes, (b) public roadways, (c) perimeter fencing as well as the wire fencing alongside the railway track that runs through the course. Note: A ball that crosses a road or fence alongside the railway track and comes to rest beyond that road or fence is out of bounds.
4. **PATHS:** All paths and maintenance roads are deemed immovable obstructions and relief may be taken. Rule 16. No Penalty.

CARTS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN FESCUE GRASSES OR NATURAL AREAS
All yardages are measured to center of greens. Sprinkler heads are marked.
